## • Schedule of Events •

### **Sunday, June 22 • Medford, Oregon**

We'll meet in Medford, conveniently located off I-5, just 60 miles north of the California border.

Long famous as the pear capitol of the world, you can tour the quaint downtown and enjoy shopping, antiques and more. Our host hotel is the **Red Lion Inn - Medford**, in the heart of downtown.

Complimentary car trailer parking will be available for the week, nearby.

5:00pm: Join us for the Tour Kickoff Party/Bufferet at the hotel.

### **Monday, June 23 • Klamath Falls, Oregon**

(Total driving today: 60 miles)

Following your complimentary continental breakfast at the Red Lion in Medford, we'll leave at approximately 10:00am for a stop nearby at *Harry and David's Country Village* to tour their fruit packing and candy kitchen, along with samples. Then enjoy lunch on your own at their cafe.

After lunch, at approximately 1:30pm we head east 60 miles to our day's destination,

The **Running Y Ranch Resort in Klamath Falls**. Running Y is a 5-star rated resort with optional activities including golf, horseback riding, a full spa, and more.

7:00pm: Western Barbeque Dinner outside at the ranch.

### **Tuesday, June 24 • Crater Lake National Park**

(Total driving today: 120 miles)

After breakfast on your own, we'll leave the Running Y at 10:00am for a day tour 60 miles north to spectacular Crater Lake National Park. This natural marvel was one of America's first national parks and is featured on the Oregon state quarter. Bring your camera as photo opportunities abound.

Bufferet lunch will be served at the historic Crater Lake Lodge, overlooking the lake.

Following lunch and exploring, we'll return to Running Y Resort for a relaxing afternoon with dinner on your own at the resort, or nearby restaurants in Klamath Falls.

### **Wednesday, June 25 • Bend, Oregon**

(Total driving today: 150 miles)

Fill-up at the breakfast buffet at the hotel then at 9:30am tour 150 miles north to Bend and our host hotel, **The Riverhouse**, along the the rapids of the Deschutes River.

Lunch on your own. At approximately 4:30pm we'll tour a few miles north to Redmond to board the Crooked River Dinner Train, an authentic 1880's railroad for an evening of dining and entertainment on the rails through the wilds of central Oregon.

Following the excursion we'll return to the Riverhouse in Bend.
