Among many special events, you will be the featured attraction at the Grand Opening of the new Murphy Auto Museum, visit the restricted Naval Base Museum in Port Hueneme, and, of course, enjoy elegant cuisine. Please sign up early for this tour so that you can receive clearance to enter the Navy base. **Schedule of Events:**

Saturday, April 22: 11:30 am. Arrive at Port Royal Restaurant for lunch. Located at the Channel Islands Marina, the Port Royal affords great views of hundreds of boats in the inland channels that make up the marina. There will be plenty of parking for your Packard as we take over at least ½ of the restaurant facilities.

1:15 pm. Tour the SeaBee Museum at the Port Hueneme Naval Base.

3:00 pm. Tour the Pacific Artists' Studio run by Teri Zaccaro, specializing in mosaics, while directly adjacent is her husband's collection of functioning Jet-powered dragsters. He is a member of the "300 mph Club."

4:00 pm. Check into the Courtyard Marriott Hotel for your two-night stay. The hotel has been recently redecorated and we have negotiated the excellent rate of \$85 per night.

6:00 pm Gather at the private and exclusive Tower Club on the 21st floor of Oxnard's tallest skyscraper for a fine meal and beautiful views of the entire Oxnard plain. The jet dragster man is our entrée to this breathtaking and impossible to obtain experience. No denim is allowed. A sport coat is required, but a tie is not.

Sunday, April 23:

6-11:50 am. Spend the morning at leisure or prepare your car for the afternoon display.

12:30 pm. Arrive at the Murphy Auto Museum for the Grand Opening festivities. Your Packard will be placed in a featured area immediately in front of the Museum entrance so that locals can enjoy your cars as much as the museum collection itself. Participate in a little Packard Outreach as you mingle with 200 estimated guests attending the event.

1:00 pm. Grand Opening begins. Peruse the 50 vintage vehicles on display and see the newly redecorated Showroom area. Fifteen Packards from 1927-1958 are on permanent display, including two former P.I. magazine "Salon Cars." There will be a BBQ lunch put on by Oxnard's finest, "It's in the Sauce," a Barbershop Quartet, some auction items, etc.

2-3:30 pm. The locals will stay until 3:30, but you decide when you are ready to take off from your reserved parking area and head out to see more of Oxnard's attractions. We recommend a driving tour of nearby farms, a stop at the Jim Hall Racing School to watch drivers training to master high speed carts, or stop for wine tasting at the brand new Herzog Winery (the only Kosher winery within ? miles).

5:30 pm. We gather in our private hotel banquet room for cocktails, dinner, awards, etc.
